Executive Committee Meeting Minutes
August 13, 2018

Chairman Dennis Gasper called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were: Dennis Gasper, Darryl Carlson, Judy Gasper, Carmen Dolson, Art DeJong, Senator Devin LeMahieu, Rep. Terry Katsma, Rep. Tyler Vorpapel, Sheriff Cory Roeseler, and Al Jante.

Secretary Judy Gasper distributed copies of the June meeting minutes, which had previously been emailed to committee members. There being no additions or corrections, Darryl made a motion to accept the minutes as distributed, motion seconded by Art, motion carried.

Judy Gasper reported that we have 206 members, no change since June's report.

Al Jante reported on the Electronic Media Committee. There have been ten Mail Chimp campaigns from July to date, and six group texts have been sent. We now have texting permission for 116 phone numbers and a \$192 balance in our texting account. Valerie Jupe has volunteered to help Al with texting.

Treasurer Jan Vojta arrived and presented the Treasurer's Report. We have cash on hand of \$15,664.39, which includes a checking account balance of \$14,628.86, a Paypal balance of \$949.53, and \$86.00 petty cash. Golf Outing receipts were \$3,865.00; we have not yet received the bills from Quit Qui Oc. Other receipts totaled \$420.00. Darryl made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report for audit, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried.

Chairman Gasper reviewed the results of the Golf Outing. Seven foursomes participated. Attorney General Brad Schimel spoke at the reception afterwards. There was discussion of contributing some proceeds to Sheriff Cory Roeseler's campaign. Darryl Carlson made a motion to contribute \$250 to the Cory Roeseler campaign, motion seconded by Art, motion carried.

The Corn Roast is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. on September 20th at our headquarters. Phone calls will be made by volunteers to invite people. Sheriff Roeseler said he has a very active Facebook page that we could use to post our events. Paul Gruber will be tasked with requesting a donation of hot dogs from Old Wisconsin; Carmen Dolson will secure the corn.

Tim Sboda and Valerie Jupe arrived.

Chairman Gasper gave an update on county fair preparations. He has purchased stickers, fifty "Keep America Great" hats, and Trump 2020 t-shirts. We also have about ten Walker t-shirts we could try to sell.

The next Executive Committee meeting will be held on September 10th.

Carmen stated that there is new voting equipment for tomorrow's primary; there will be reps from the company it was purchased from to assist if there are any problems.

Chairman Gasper reviewed the campaign season situation. We probably won't get an RPW staff person at our headquarters, so we will have to take on more responsibility ourselves. Someone has volunteered to supervise lit drops.

Tim Sboda introduced himself. He has worked for Congressman Glenn Grothman in Washington, D.C., and has been assigned to assist Glenn in Wisconsin with his campaign. It will be a very expensive race, and probably closer than usual for the 6th District.

Senator Devin LeMahieu, Rep. Terry Katsma, Rep. Tyler Vorpapel, and Sheriff Cory Roeseler gave updates on their campaigns.

There being no further business, Darryl made a motion to adjourn, motion seconded by Carmen, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
