Executive Committee Meeting Minutes
August 7, 2017

Chairman Dennis Gasper called the meeting to order at 7:17 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were: Dennis Gasper, Darryl Carlson, Judy Gasper, Art DeJong, Pat Schutt; Paul Gruber arrived at 7:25 p.m.

Secretary Judy Gasper distributed copies of the July meeting minutes, which had also been emailed to committee members. There being no additions or corrections, Darryl made a motion to accept the minutes as distributed, Art seconded the motion, motion carried.

Treasurer Phil Parker was not in attendance, so there was no Treasurer's Report. Chairman Gasper stated that he thought we have about \$14,000.00 in our checking account.

Judy Gasper reported that our membership is 196, unchanged since the July meeting. Pat suggested that we encourage those who "like" us on Facebook to become members if they aren't already members. She was assigned this task.

Plans for the Sheboygan County Fair booth were discussed. Chairman Gasper has ordered fifty "Trump 2020" hats and bumper stickers to sell. We will also be selling buttons, which can be made as needed. We plan to promote membership and conduct a straw poll of some kind.

The September 21st Corn Roast was discussed. Carmen Dolson will be asked to update the invitation before the County Fair so we can hand them out there. Paul will also ask Carmen to contact Mr. Otte about supplying the corn. It was decided to raise the price from \$5 to \$7 per person. Darryl will contact Kevin Nicholson and Leah Vukmir to see if they would be interested in speaking to our group.

Chairman Gasper said that RPW will be holding a seminar titled "How to Win Elections" at our headquarters on August 23rd. Also, the Manitowoc County Republicans will hold a Marine Sanctuary meeting on August 29th.

There being no further business, Paul made a motion to adjourn, motion seconded by Darryl, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8 p.m.
