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Constitution Of The 1 Republican Party of Sheboygan County 2 3 Article I - Name 4 5 6 The name of this unincorporated organization shall be "The Republican Party of Sheboygan 7 County" (RPSC). 8 **Article II – Purpose** 9 10 11 This voluntary organization exists to unify under one central organization the activities of the RPSC, to advance fundamental Republican principles and policies, to cooperate and assist in 12 all county, state and national elections, and to preserve for all people our Republican form of 13 14 government, as created under the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Wisconsin. 15 16 **Article III - Powers** 17 18 19 The RPSC shall have all powers under law to manage, control and supervise its affairs, 20 property, and funds to meet its purposes. 21 **Article IV – Membership** 22 23 24 Membership in this organization shall be open to any Sheboygan County resident of voting age who believes in the objectives, purposes, and principles of the RPSC as expressed in this 25 Constitution. The membership year shall commence on January 1st and end on 26 December 31st. Members in good standing shall be those who pay annual dues prior to a 27 caucus. New members will be able to vote by paying annual dues ten (10) days in advance of a 28 29 caucus. 30 Article V - Board 31 32 33 Section 1. The RPSC shall be governed by a Board consisting of: 34 35 a. Nine voting members Four officers i. 36 Five committee chairs 37 38 Nonvoting members b. RPSC members elected to the State Assembly and State Senate 39 i. 40 ii. RPSC members elected to or appointed to Congressional District or State of Wisconsin offices 41 42 43 Section 2. A vacancy of any Board member shall be filled by appointment of the Chair with 44 the approval of the Board for the unexpired portion of the term. 45 46 Section 3. Board members shall be elected to two (2) year terms commencing at the

conclusion of the caucus and can be nominated for consecutive terms.
